Process for using MFA authentication

If you are comfortable setting up the app move to Part 2







Step 2 For the first time you will be prompted by a Welcome message.




Then a Secure Your Accounts screen. Click


After these initial screens you will be prompted Is this your first time connecting an account to **Salesforce Authenticator?** Click Yes



Navigate back to your mobile device and open the Salesforce Authenticator App.






